



This series of teacher's resource material has been published with specific learning objectives in mind, and have proven to be very popular with students.

All activities have been written by Australian teachers with other Australian teachers in mind. They have all been extensively trialled in the classroom and students welcome the challenge of completing them with enthusiasm.

I am an experienced teacher and recognise the need for students to develop an ownership in what they read. For this reason I have developed this personalised reader system. I have used this approach for many years and find it invaluable in motivating students to begin reading.

This graded material allows the student to illustrate their own series of readers, thus motivating them by giving them direct input and allowing a multitude of readers to be available at next to no cost.

The actual construction of the readers is very straight-forward, with the students supplying illustrations firstly and then cutting out each page and assembling them with glue or the teacher using staples.

A blank template is provided for readers to be custom made for specific class themes, extension activities or remediation.

These readers should not be used in isolation but as part of an overall classroom-based reading program. They can be read in class and used as a take-home practice reader. They can be used in conjunction with other reading aids such as flashcards, games, tapes, phonic drills, word building games etc.
