
INTRODUCTION

The sheets in 'Classroom Display - Digraphs' are designed to be used as classroom displays or for individual, group or class activities to re-inforce the recognition of digraphs.


These pages can be used a number of different ways e.g.


- 1] Larger displays can be easily achieved by enlarging the pages to A3 size. The title and page numbers on the bottom of the page can be cut off first with a pair of scissors. These displays can be coloured to make them more appealing and laminated for durability.
- The large pictures and sounds at the beginning of the book can also be used as a starting point for further class displays. The students can sort through the other pictures selected from this book to match words which contain the 'digraph' and then paste these around the picture.
- The rest of this book contains lists of words or pictures and words for each digraph.

 These can be coloured, displayed or used as a starting point for other games and classroom activities e.g.



a) The words can be cut out, mixed up and sorted into digraph groups. The results can be pasted together on a large sheet of paper.







- b) Multiple copies of each page can be made and used to play a game of concentration. Students are placed into pairs or small groups and the word cards (2 of each) are shuffled and placed face down on the desk. The students take it in turns to turn over a word card. When they can match two cards they keep them. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game is the winner.
- c) One copy of each of the word cards are shuffled and each student is dealt 4 to 6 cards which are placed face up in front of them. The teacher or a student calls out or holds up a 'sound/digraph' card. If the student has a word with that sound they place a counter on it. When they have all of their words covered they call out 'Bingo'.
- 4] The pages at the back of the book contain N.S.W., Queensland and Victorian scripts. These sounds can be cut out and pasted over the top of other pages in the book before they are photocopied, in order to modify the font to match your state.


