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
# INTRODUCTION

The sheets in 'Classroom Display - Single Sounds' are designed to be used as classroom displays or for individual, group or class activities to re-inforce the recognition of single sounds.


These pages can be used a number of different ways e.g.


- 1] Larger displays can be easily achieved by enlarging the pages to A3 size. The title and page numbers on the bottom of the page can be cut off first with a pair of scissors. These displays can be coloured to make them more appealing and laminated for durability.
- The students colour, paint or use various paper skills to decorate the sheets which can then be displayed in the classroom. The large pictures at the front of the book are ideal for craft activities and could also be used as a starting point for further large displays e.g.

  The students could use chips of red paper to decorate the large apple and trace over the sound and word in bright colours. This could then be displayed with other smaller 'a' pictures from elsewhere in this book or cut from magazines by the students.



- The rest of this book contains numerous smaller pictures, grouped alphabetically. These can be coloured, displayed or used as a starting point for other games and classroom activities e.g.
  - a) The students can colour and cut out each small picture. These can then be mixed up and sorted into different sound groups then pasted together on a large sheet of paper e.g.





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
b) Multiple copies of each page can be made and used to play a game of concentration. Students are placed into pairs or small groups and the picture cards (2 of each) are shuffled and placed face down on the desk. The students take it in turns to turn over a picture card. When they


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match two cards they keep them. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game is the winner.


c) One copy of each of the picture cards are shuffled and each student is dealt 4 to 6 cards which


- are placed face up in front of them. The teacher or a student calls out or holds up a card with a sound on it. If the student has a picture starting with that sound they place a counter on it. When they have all of their pictures covered they call out 'Bingo'.
- d) The pictures and sounds can be cut apart. The students have to match the word or sound to the correct picture and paste it onto a piece of paper.
- 4] The pages at the back of the book contain N.S.W., Queensland and Victorian scripts. These sounds can be cut out and pasted over the top of other pages in the book before they are photocopied, in order to modify the font to match your state. The pictures on the sound pages are different for each state so that there is a greater variety when they are used in the above activities.
- 5] Blank templates are provided for the teacher to expand this program.






















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


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











































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



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
































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






























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





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
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



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



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














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
